

The Gospel

One definition of the Gospel (Good News) is the following by Ed Stetzer.

The Gospel is

- the good news that God, who is more holy than we can imagine, looked upon with compassion, people, who are more sinful than we would possibly admit, and sent Jesus into history to establish His kingdom and reconcile people and the world to Himself.

- Jesus, whose love is more extravagant than we can measure, came to sacrificially die for us so that we might gain through His grace what the Bible defines as eternal life through His death and resurrection,

- to know the only true God, take hold of His present life by the direction and abundant strength afforded to us by and through the Spirit.

While the above is a bit complicated and drawn out, you could shorten it as you put it in your own words. Illustrate it with your own conversion experience. Tell someone how to become a Christian from your personal experience of Jesus. Let them know of the coming judgment upon sin by God. Make sure they understand that receiving Jesus as Savior and Lord is the only escape from that coming judgment, and its sentence to hell.
